## MISSION:

---

The mission of Life Pacific College is to support the advance of the Kingdom of God through education and training.

## LOCATION:

---

Life Pacific College is located in Los Angeles County in sunny Southern California near the intersection of the I-210 and I-57 Freeways. San Dimas is an equestrian town of 36,000, nestled in the foothills of the San Gabriel mountains. The college is conveniently located 45 minutes from snowskiing and beaches, and just 25 minutes North of Disneyland and adjacent attractions.

## MINISTRY PLACEMENT:

---

LIFE offers formal career services for current students, graduates and alumni. The office coordinates with churches, supervisors, non-profit organizations, and businesses to advertise ministry opportunities.

## ADMISSION:

---

High School graduation or equivalent is required. College prep curriculum is recommended, although specific high school courses are not required.

## ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

---

The applicant should have led a consistent Christian life for a minimum of one year prior to attendance and must submit the following:

- \* Application & \$35 application fee
- \* Application Essay
- \* Pastor's Reference Form
- \* Official high school transcript
- \* Official college transcripts of all schools attended whether or not courses are deemed transferable
- \* Official SAT or ACT test score

The decision of the Admissions Committee can be expected within two weeks after the above materials have been received.

## POST ACCEPTANCE:

---

Once the applicant has been accepted, the following items will be due:

- \* \$100 Tuition Deposit
- \* Health Form with TD, MMR and Meningitis Immunizations
- \* Housing Application and \$200 Deposit

## APPLICATION DEADLINE:

---

- \* May 1<sup>st</sup> for fall semester
- \* November 1<sup>st</sup> for spring semester

## CAMPUS LIFE

---

- \* All students are allowed to have cars, including freshmen.
- \* 65% of students live in the residence halls. Meals are included in the Café for on-campus students. Off campus students may purchase meals.
- \* Alcohol, tobacco, and gambling are not permitted.

## FINANCIAL AID:

---

LIFE is a recognized organization through the United States Department of Education. Therefore, eligible students may receive Title IV funds. To apply for these funds, the applicant must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after January 1 of the academic school year they plan to attend LIFE:

- \* Pell Grant (federal grant) based upon family income.
- \* CAL Grant (state grant) based on family income and cumulative GPA (for California Residents only). GPA Verification Form and FAFSA must be submitted and postmarked by March 2 for this grant.
- \* Low Interest Government Loans: LIFE participates in the Federal Family Educational Loan Program (FFELP), which includes Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans for qualifying students. Loan amounts range from \$5500-\$7500 per academic year. Parents also have the option to borrow a PLUS loan which is for dependent undergraduate students.

Scholarships become available during the school year, such as The Endowed Scholarships, and Academic Dean Scholarships. Over 80% of all LIFE students receive some form of financial aid.

## FACILITIES:

Life Pacific College moved to San Dimas from Los Angeles in 1990. Most of our facilities have been built since that time, and sit on a beautifully lush, tropically landscaped campus.

### ALUMNI LIBRARY

The LIFE Alumni Library is well-equipped to serve the students with 42,000 volumes, 2,000 serial subscriptions via electronic files, and 1,700 audio-visual materials. Online Access Catalog (OPAC) is available.

### THE HICKS MEMORIAL STUDENT CENTER

The newest addition to the campus, this beautiful center is the hub of student life, and contains:

- \* The Mehl Court Gymnasium - Named after esteemed alumnus, Pastor Ron Mehl, this facility was dedicated in 2003 and is a welcome addition to our campus.
- \* Work-out facilities - Exercise equipment and locker rooms are available to all students, whether living on or off-campus.
- \* Arts and Science Lab - This well-equipped facility has added greatly to the academic program.
- \* Private Prayer Rooms - available to all students
- \* The Loop - featuring big screen TV room, pool table, coffee and snack bar, jukebox, and vending machines
- \* Music & Arts Facilities - music & performing arts room, recording studio, practice rooms, and piano lab

## RESIDENCE HALLS

LIFE has four residence halls and our students love them! Each room accommodates two students and is furnished with a bunk bed (storage drawers under each bed), two chests of drawers, two desks, and a closet.
