

*The following information is given to assist you in understanding how courses may transfer and apply to a traditional BA degree at Life Pacific College*

**Core Courses That Transfer:**

- English Composition (*college composition with research paper*)
- Literature elective
- Math elective (*e.g. business math, college algebra, statistics, accounting, economics*)
- Science with a lab (*e.g. astronomy, biology, chemistry, geology, meteorology, oceanography, physics*)
- Social and Behavioral Science elective (*e.g. anthropology, geography, political science, psychology, sociology; Intro to Psychology or Sociology is required for Transformational Ministry BA*)
- History elective (*e.g. any history course*)
- Speech (*public speaking course – must include delivery of speeches*)
- Humanities elective (*e.g. music, art, philosophy, languages, drama*)

**Other Courses that transfer for Open Electives:**

(Biblical Studies BA has 18 open electives and Transformational Ministry BA has 8 Open electives)

- Communication
- English/Writing
- Computer Basics
- Foreign Languages
- Critical Thinking
- Health
- Education
- Any college level course

**Classes are transferred on a course-by-course basis.** Credit is given for those courses taken at another college that match our basic content and emphasis. Courses must have at least half the credit of our equivalent course in order to fulfill the specific Life Pacific College course requirement.

- Students transferring a science course with a lab from a secular institution will be required to take “Readings in Scientific Thought” to fulfill the science requirement.
- Only courses in which the student has earned a grade of C- or above may transfer.
- Credits from some recognized but **non-accredited schools** will transfer. In this case, transcripts are evaluated at the time of your acceptance as a student at LIFE, but the actual transfer of credit is not made until you have completed 24 units of study in an accredited institution with a minimum GPA of 2.0 (C average).
